Summary of Cyclone Sidr Response

Updated official report from MoFDM illustrates that the number of death caused by tropical cyclone 'SIDR' has risen to **3275 affecting 8.5 million** people of **1.9 million** families. These casualties and damages of houses, livestock, crops, educational institutions, roads and embankments have been reported from 1871 unions of 200 upazilas of 30 districts. Most deaths and damages have been attributed to the storm surge.

AFD is working on non-stop basis and carrying the relief goods to the local administrations, communities at the very remote locations by both BAF and US Aircrafts. Yesterday BAF carried 25051 kg relief items to cyclone affected areas by 05 sorties and today they scheduled 03 sorties to carry relief items to cyclone affected areas.

Up to Friday, December 30, 2007 GoB have allocated approx 507 million BDT from Honorable Chief Advisor's Relief & Welfare Fund and DRR, MoFDM for the Sidr victims. GoB has also allocated 16890 MT GR Rice, distributed 27,000 food bags, 26700 blankets, 16454 tents, 3,348 utensils and 13,000 bundles of CI sheets by the Directorate of Relief and Rehabilitation (DRR).

Actions Taken:

- BDT 500000 G. R Cash has been allocated to the Relief and Coordination cell in Barisal district for Rescue and relief operations.
- Last 29th November, 2007 BDT 300 million has been allocated to the highly affected 9 districts as a house building grant from Chief **Adviser's Relief and Welfare Fund**.
- Medicine 48 packets, Alam Feric 40 packets, ready food 333 packets, water filter 5000pcs, Milk powder 666 packets blanket 6000 pcs from the contribution of India Government have been hand over to the Armed Forces for distributing to the affected people.

Situation Report

- A total of BDT 300000 G. R. Cash has been allocated to Madaripur, Shariatpur, and Gopalganj districts for rescue operation and rehabilitation process.
- 2000 metric ton G. R Rice has been allocated to Bagerhat, Patuakhali, Barguna and Pirojpur districts yesterday where each districts got 500 metric ton.
- 50000 Packet Relief items have been allocated to the severe affected 9 districts provided by Royal Soudi Government.
- 750 pcs blanket and 480 bottle mineral water (2 litre) provided by 71st batch student society of Motijheel Govt. boys school has been hand overed to the **Chief Adviser's Relief and Welfare Fund**.
- 87.085 metric ton relief items (tent, blanket and fast food) from the contribution of Royal Soudi Government have been hand over to the Armed Forces for distribution to the affected area.

Operations by Armed Forces Divisions (AFD)

BAF scheduled to operate 03 sorties today. C-130 and AN-32 are used to carry relief items to the affected areas.

US Army transferred 2 Ton Food through 03 sorties by their C-130.

US Marine operated 06 sorties to carry relief items. Two CH-46 carried 2 Ton Food each, Two UC-35 carried 2 Ton Food Shelter and Food respectively and Two CH-53 carried 2 Ton Food, Water and USAID respectively.

Yesterday BAF operated total 05 sorties. 2 helicopter carried 4351 (1900+2451) kg, 02 C-130 carried 15495 (8049+7446) kg and 01 AN-32 carried 5205 kg of relief materials to exaggerated areas.

Yesterday US Army transferred 21162 kg relief items thorough 03 sorties by their C-130.

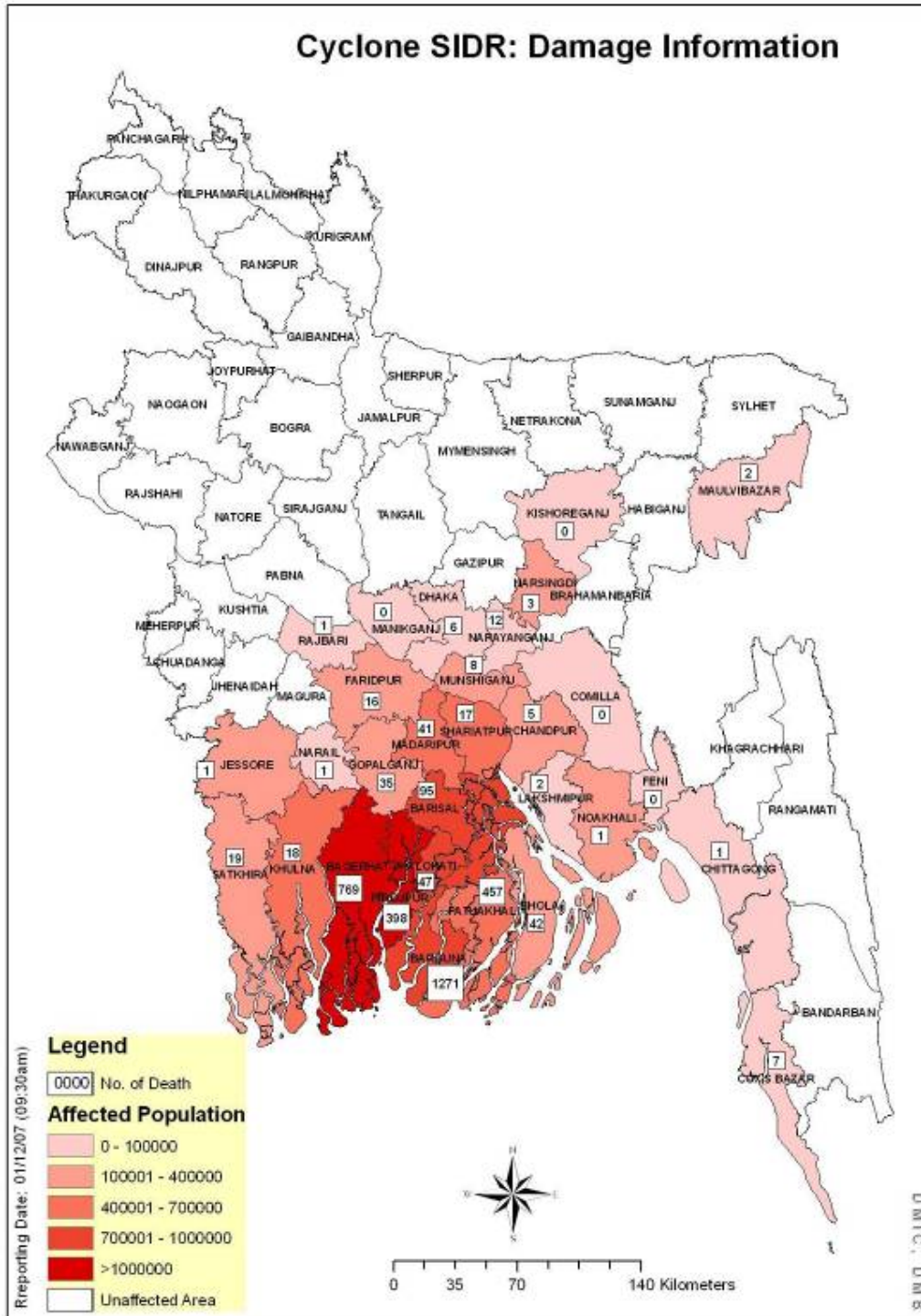
